IPN Honored with Public Communication and Knowledge Award

• IPN Director General Arturo Reyes Sandoval received the award and reaffirmed the Institute's commitment to using every available tool to share its work with society.

The Instituto Politécnico Nacional (IPN) received the Crónica Award for Public Communication and Knowledge 2025 in recognition of its outstanding work in scientific and technological dissemination—carried out with rigor, awareness, and social commitment through Canal Once and Radio IPN.

The award ceremony took place at the Jaime Torres Bodet Auditorium of the National Museum of Anthropology, where IPN Director General Arturo Reyes Sandoval accepted the honor from former UNAM Rector José Narro Robles.

In his remarks, Dr. Reyes Sandoval expressed his gratitude for the recognition and highlighted the vital role that Canal Once and Radio IPN have played over the years in communicating the Politécnico's work and bringing science and knowledge closer to Mexican society.

He reaffirmed his conviction that spreading knowledge and culture is a vital need: "We believe that humanity has been built on the foundation of shared knowledge—using our intelligence to turn ideas into advances and insights that benefit society.
